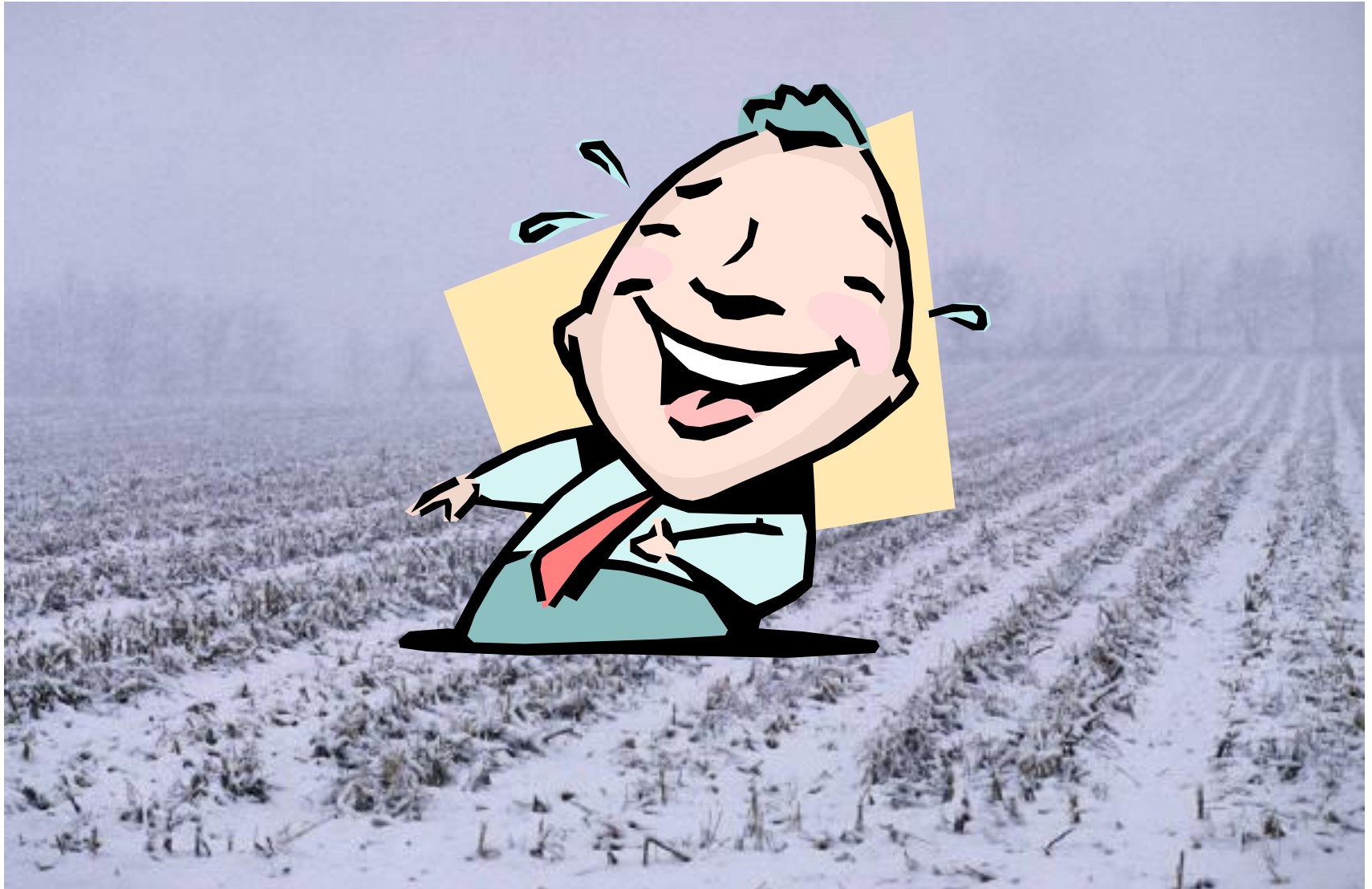


Jingle Bells

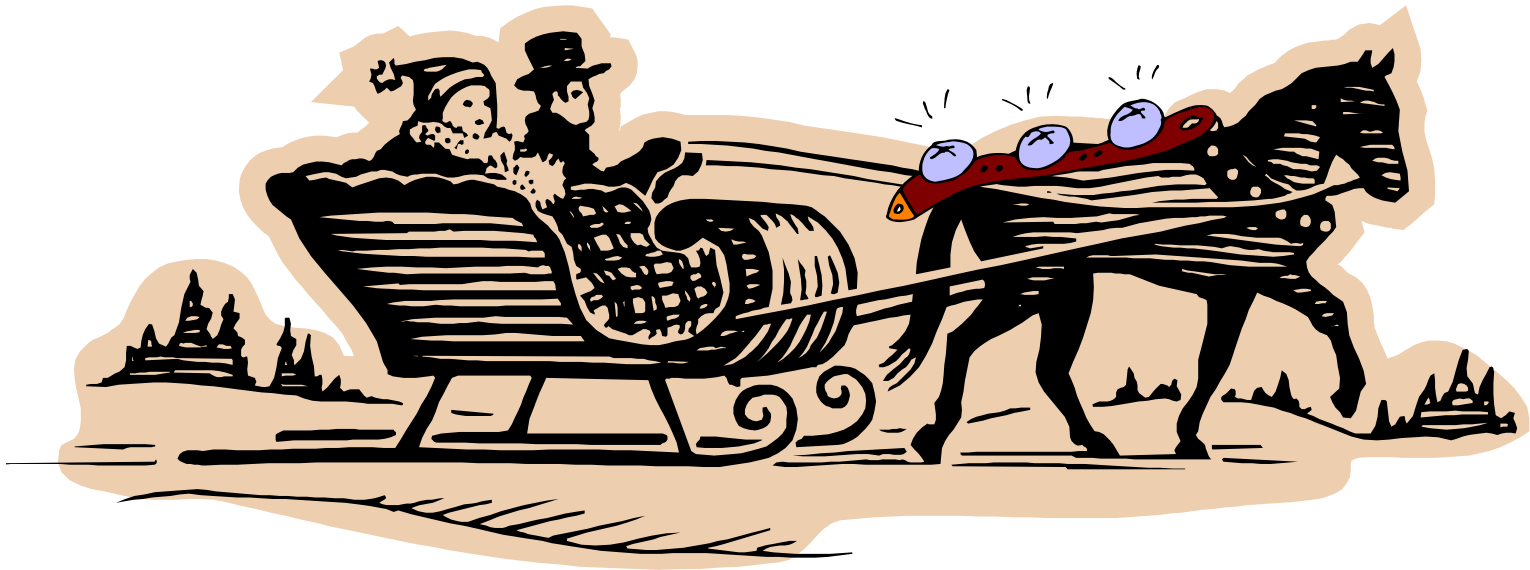
Dashing through the snow, in a one-

making spirits bright,



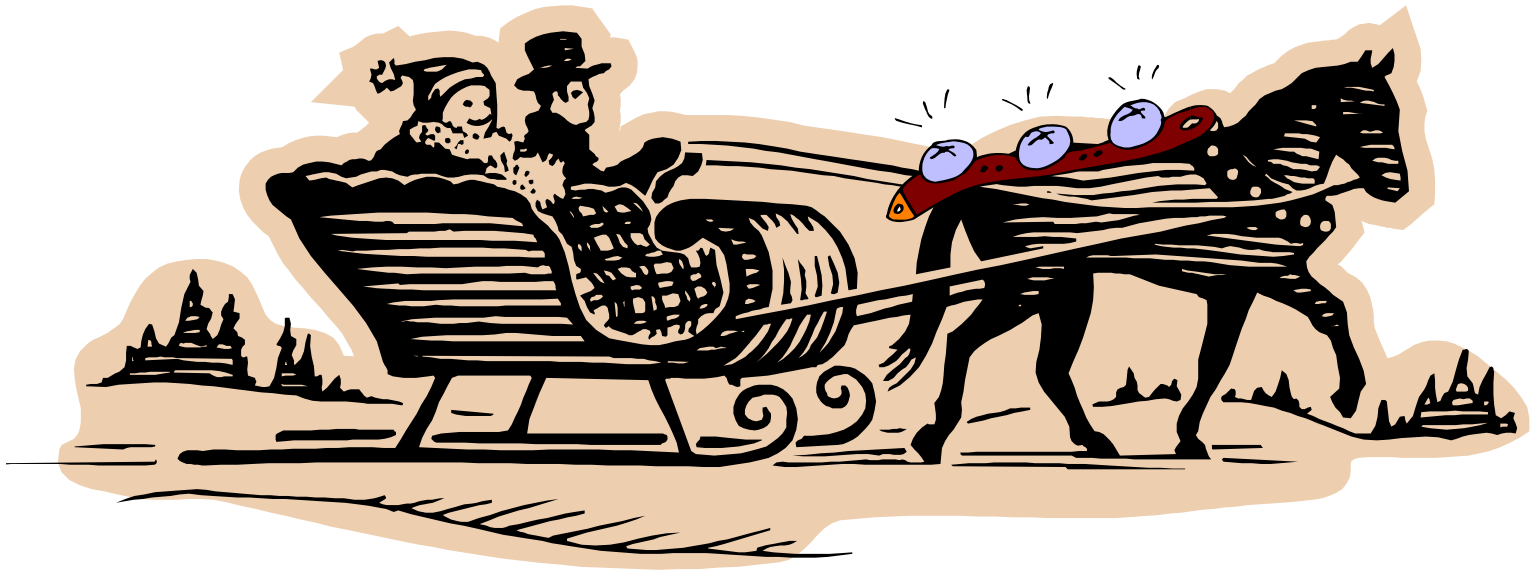
What fun it is to ride and sing a sleighing song tonight.

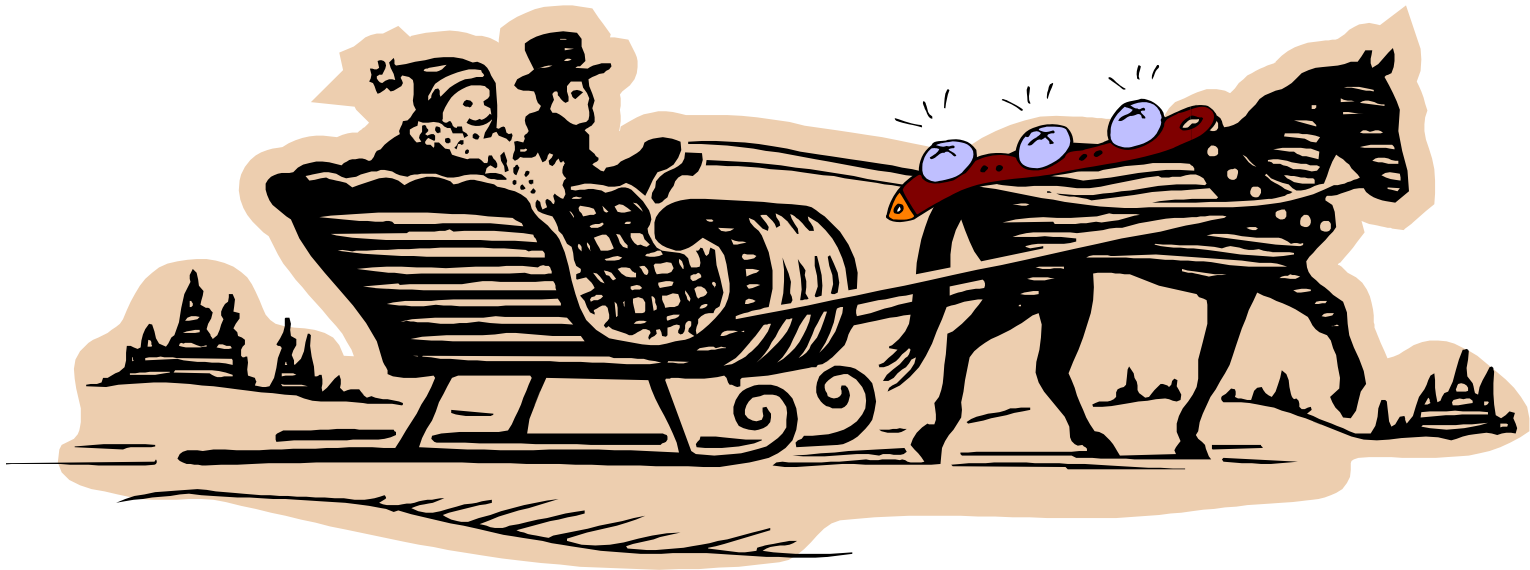
