The First Noel

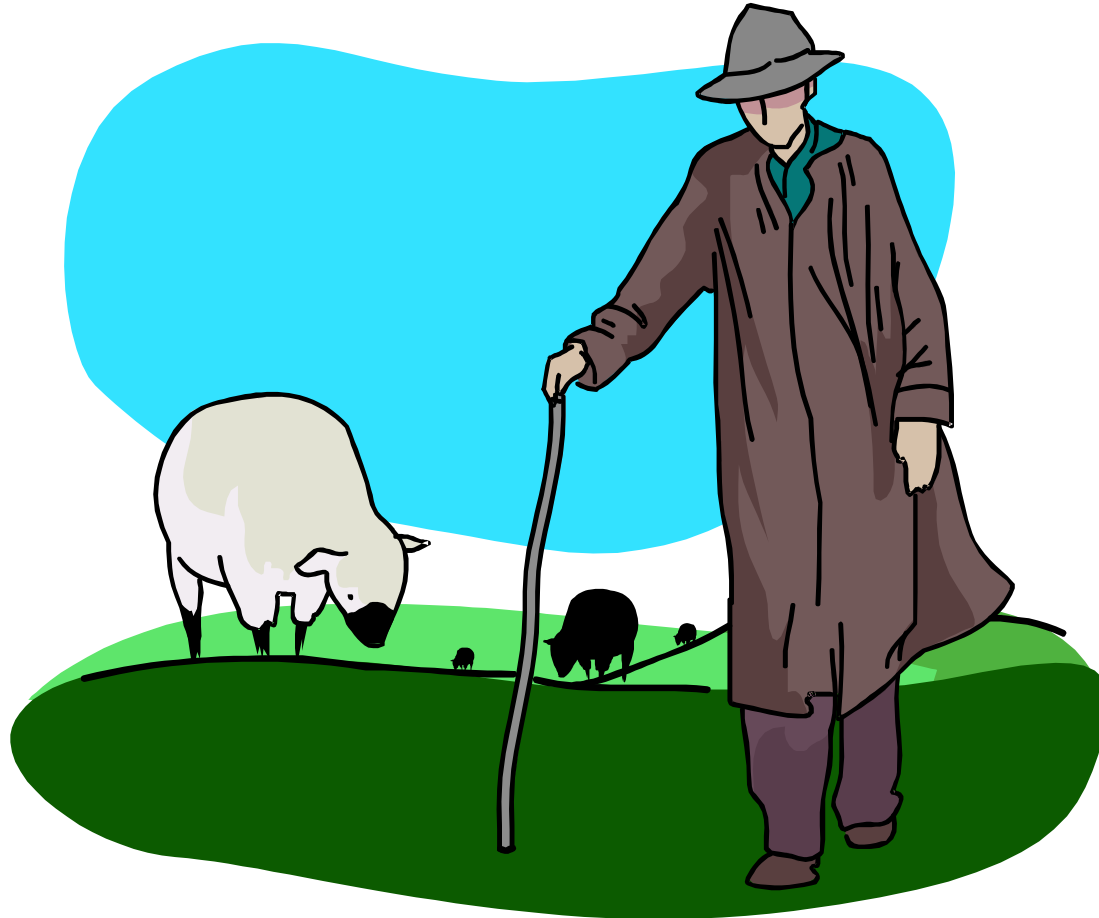
The first Noel the angel did say
