

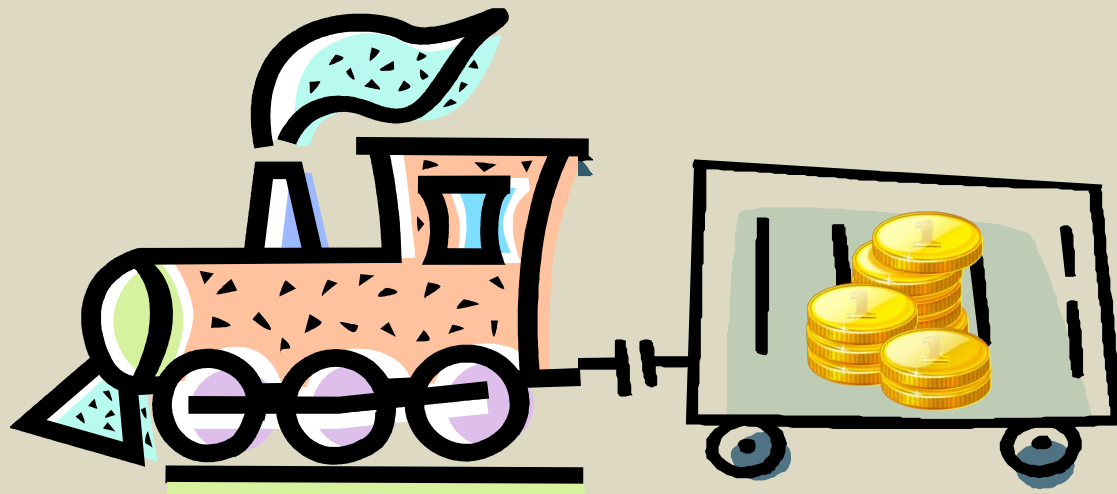

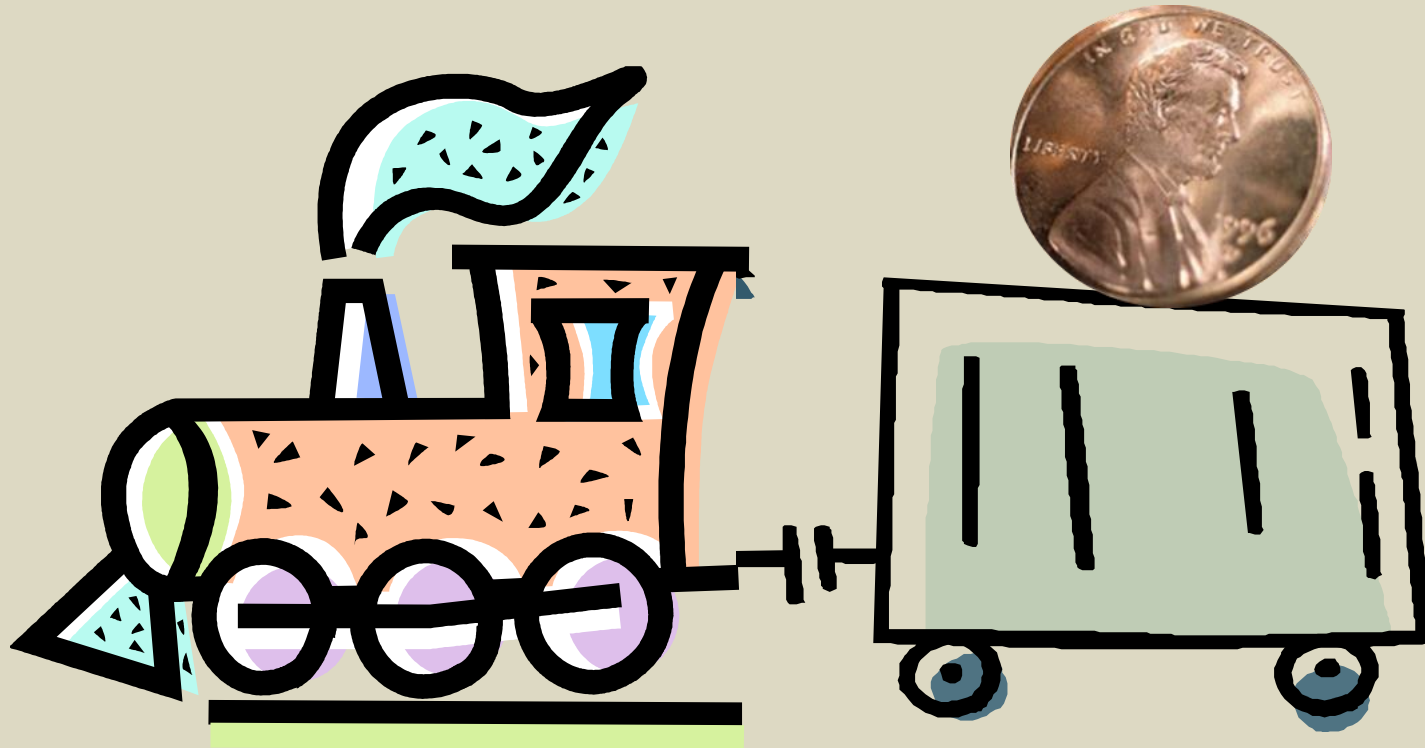

Includes penny, nickel, dime, and quarter.

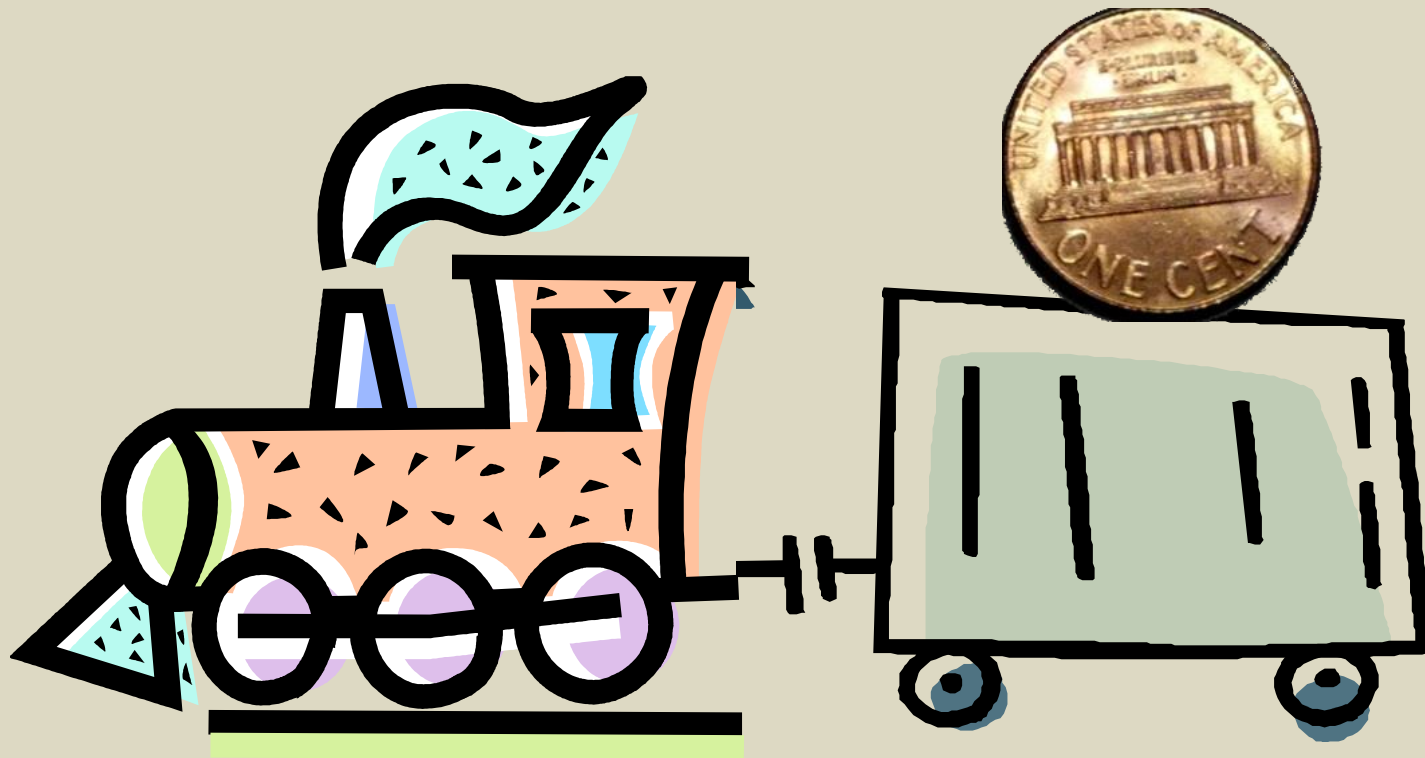
