

Attending Church on Easter Sunday

Easter is a holiday that represents the resurrection of Jesus.

As part of our Easter celebrations, my family likes to go to church on Easter Sunday. There are many ways that different churches celebrate Easter.

At some churches, they have what is called a "Sunrise Service." If we go to a Sunrise Service, we will wake up very early in the morning to go to church. This service might be outside or it might be in the regular church building.

If we don't go to Sunrise Service, we might go to church later in the morning at the regular church time.

If the service is inside the church building, there are a few things we will need to remember.

- 1. People are expected to sit (mostly) still in the pews, benches, or chairs while the church service is taking place.
- 2. People are expected to be quiet during the church service so they can listen to the pastor, minister, or another person speaking at the service.
- 3. If there is something urgent I need to say to my family, I can whisper to them.
- 4. On Easter, many people like to dress-up in nice, or formal, clothes. My family can help with letting me know which types of clothes are appropriate to wear on Easter Sunday.
- 5. My family enjoys going to church on Easter, so they will really appreciate it if I try to remember to do the steps listed above while I go to church with them.
