"Reading and Copywork for Kids Who Love Trains"

This book of activities and lessons is designed to provide you, as a teacher or parent, with reading and writing activities that motivate your child or students to learn. When we build children's interests into our lessons and learning activities, children are more naturally motivated to complete the work, allowing us to use less external rewards and consequences to ensure that schoolwork is completed.

This book is written for children who have an understanding of letters and which sounds they make and that have a special interest in trains. In my years of teaching special education, many of my students (particularly those with autism) have been very interested in trains. Using train-themed learning activities has been highly motivating for my students, helping them focus on their work with less struggle and distraction and more fun and enjoyment. The illustrations are designed to be simple, so as to provide a visual cue without distracting the student.

On the following pages, you'll find these motivating learning activities, ready to print and use with your children or students.

How to Use the Reading Activities

Each reading lesson focuses on a short line or passage, and the child will practice reading and "building" all of the words in the line or passage. Each lesson contains four steps per word, all of which should be completed in about 15 minutes or less. Keep the lesson short.


- 1. The teacher chooses one word from the passage to introduce first. He or she writes it on a board or piece of paper to show the child. The teacher tells the child what the word is and they talk about any experiences the child has had with the word. For example, if the word is "hill," you can talk about a time the child went sledding down a hill. Talking about experiences may not apply to basic words, such as "is" or "and."
- 2. The teacher lays out on the table a set of word cards, one card for each word in the passage. The teacher asks the child to find the word discussed in step one.
- 3. The teacher asks the child to build the word with letter tiles. For example, the child would put the letter tiles "h" "i" "l" and "l" in next to each other in order to spell the word "hill."
- 4. The teacher invites the child to find the word in the printed passage and read the word aloud.
- 5. This sequence is repeated for each other word in the passage. After all words are completed, the child reads the whole line or passage.

As an extension activity, you can use the individual letter tiles to build new words with a key word from the passage. For example, you can transform the word "hill" into "mill," "bill," "hull," etc. by moving around the letter tiles.



How to Use the Copy Work Activities


In order to practice handwriting and writing letters, students copy the train-related words on the blank lines below the typed text.

Here is an example:




You can laminate the pages, and have the students write with a thin-tip dry erase marker so the pages can be used more than once.
