

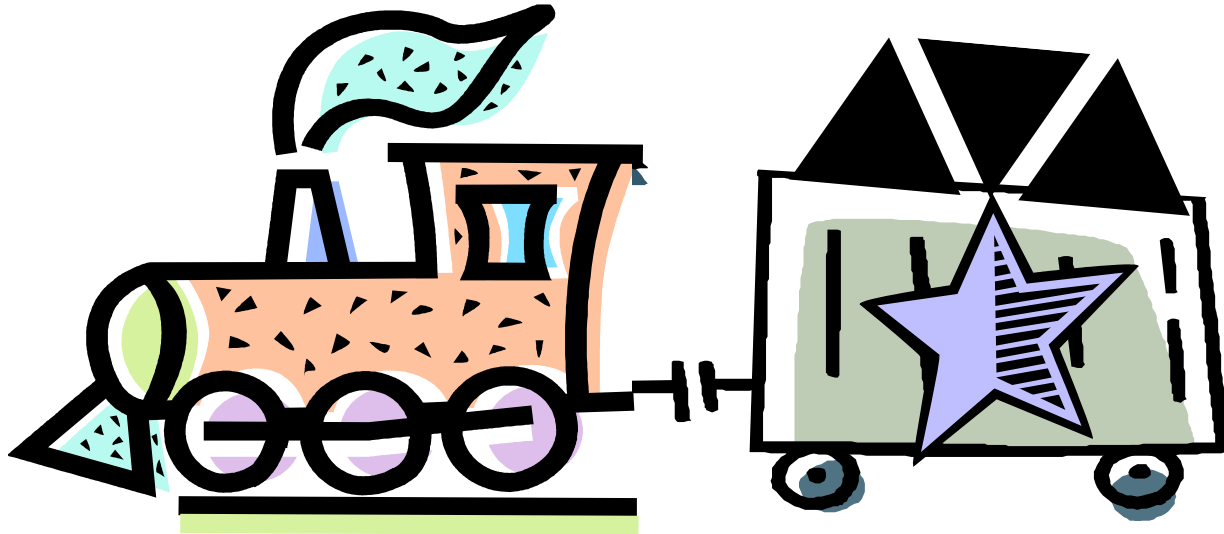

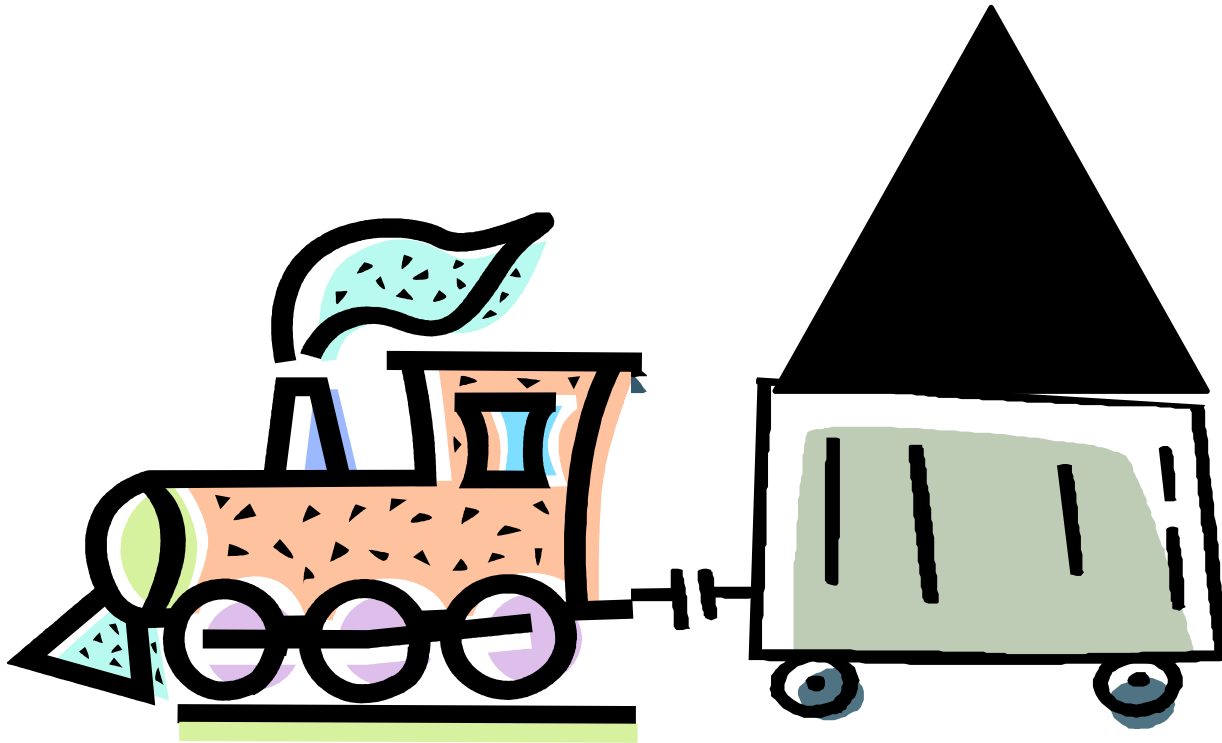

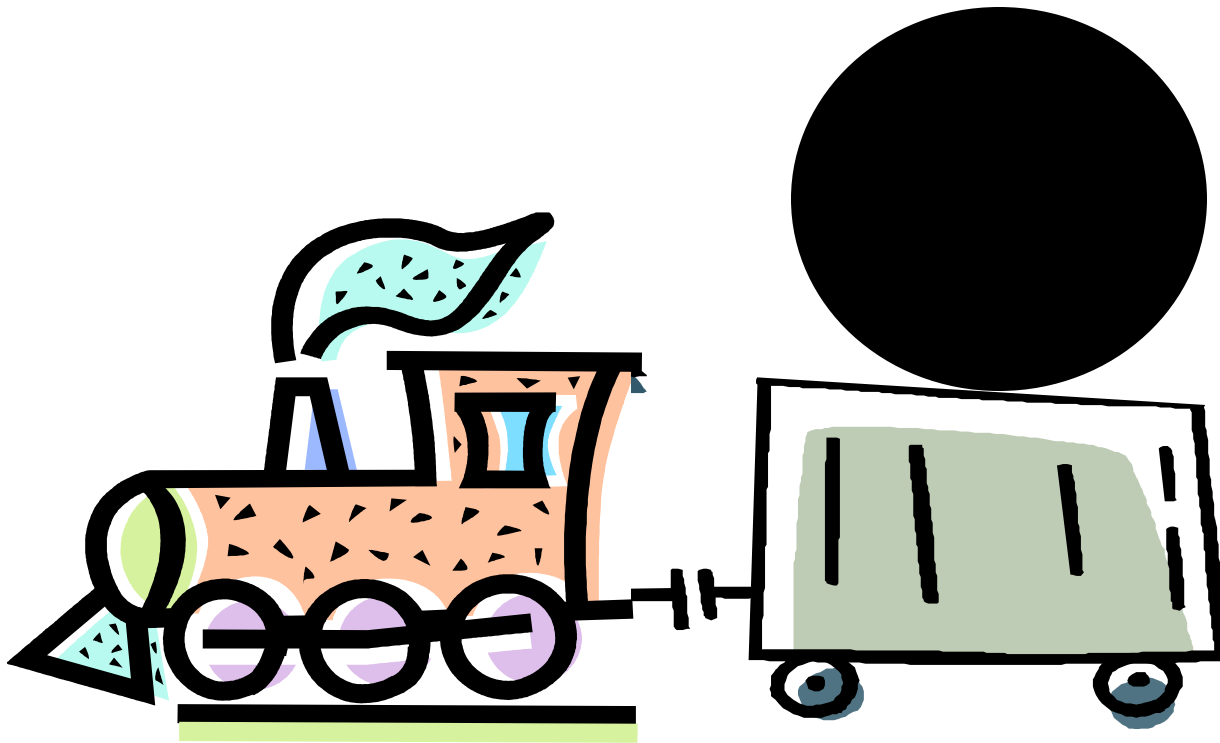
Travis the Train has an important job today. He is delivering shapes.



Travis delivers a triangle.



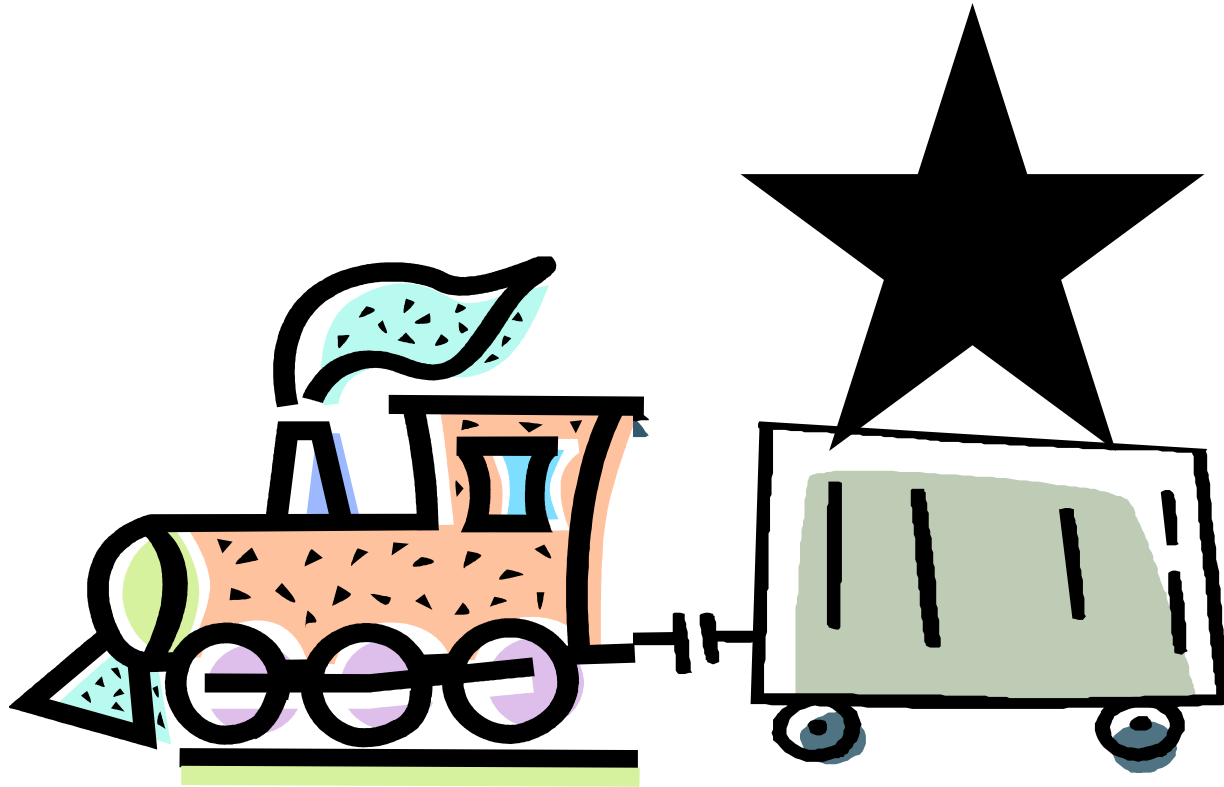
Travis delivers a circle.

Travis delivers a star.

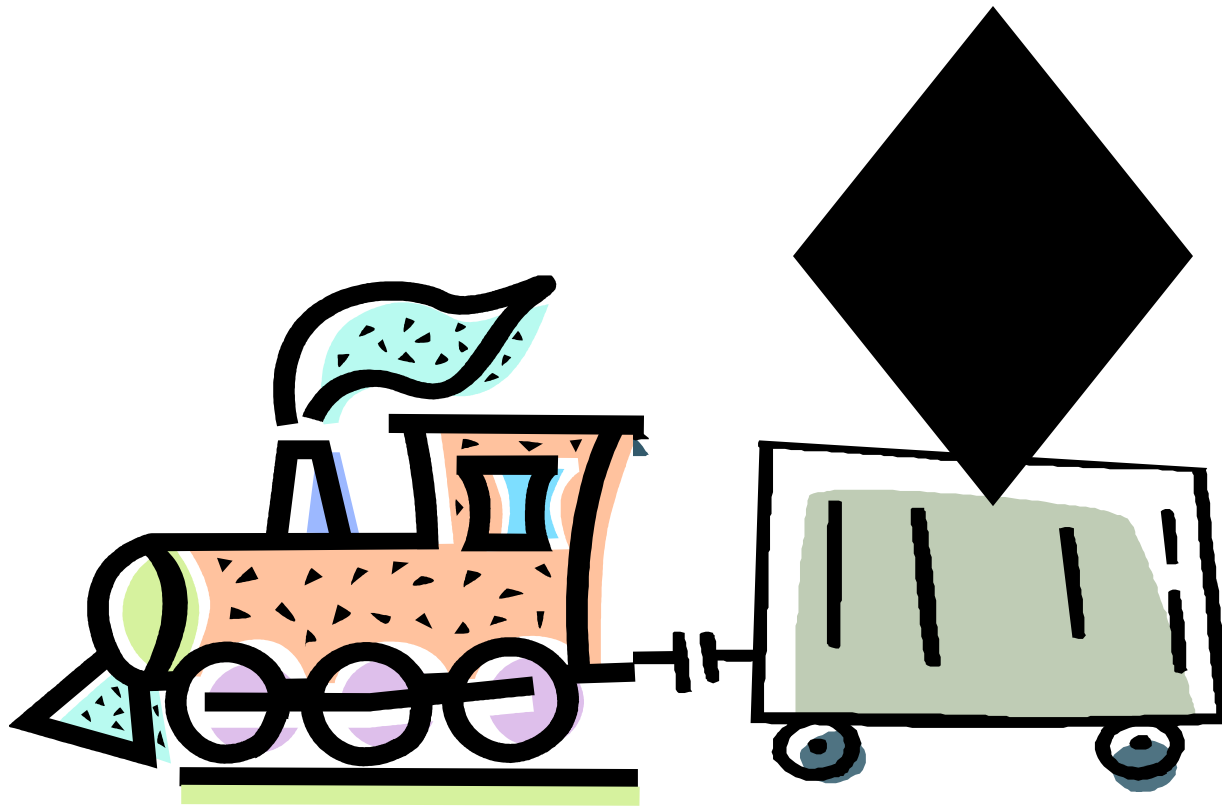


Travis delivers a heart.

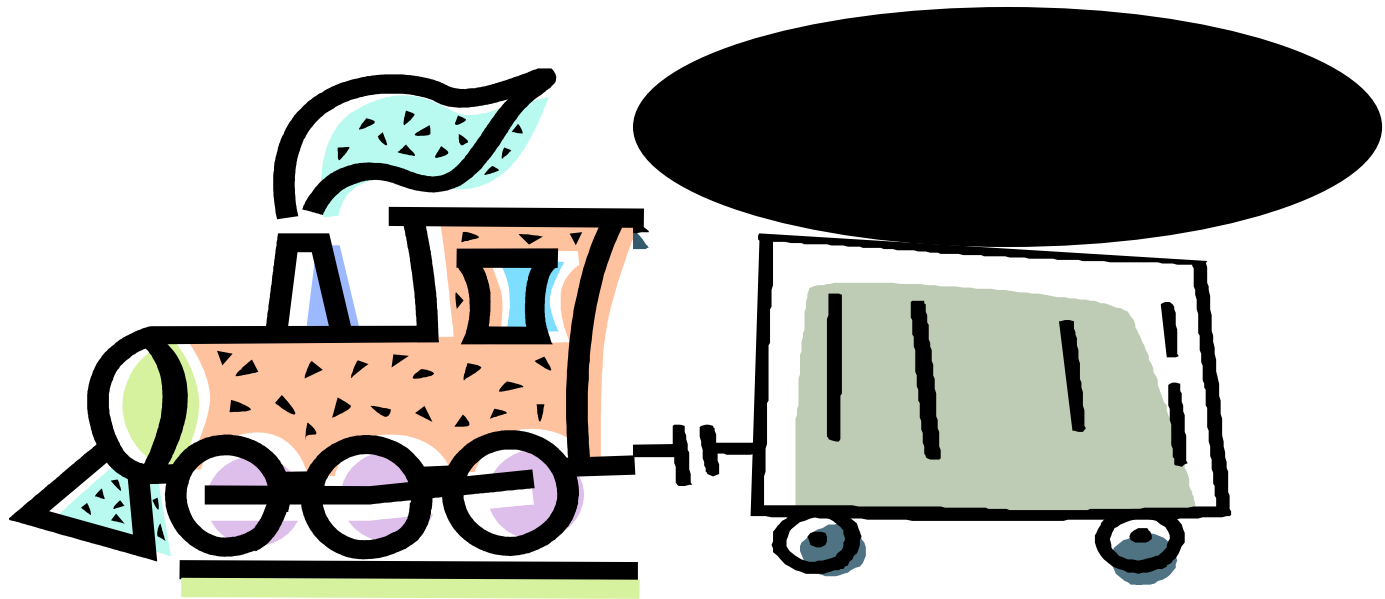




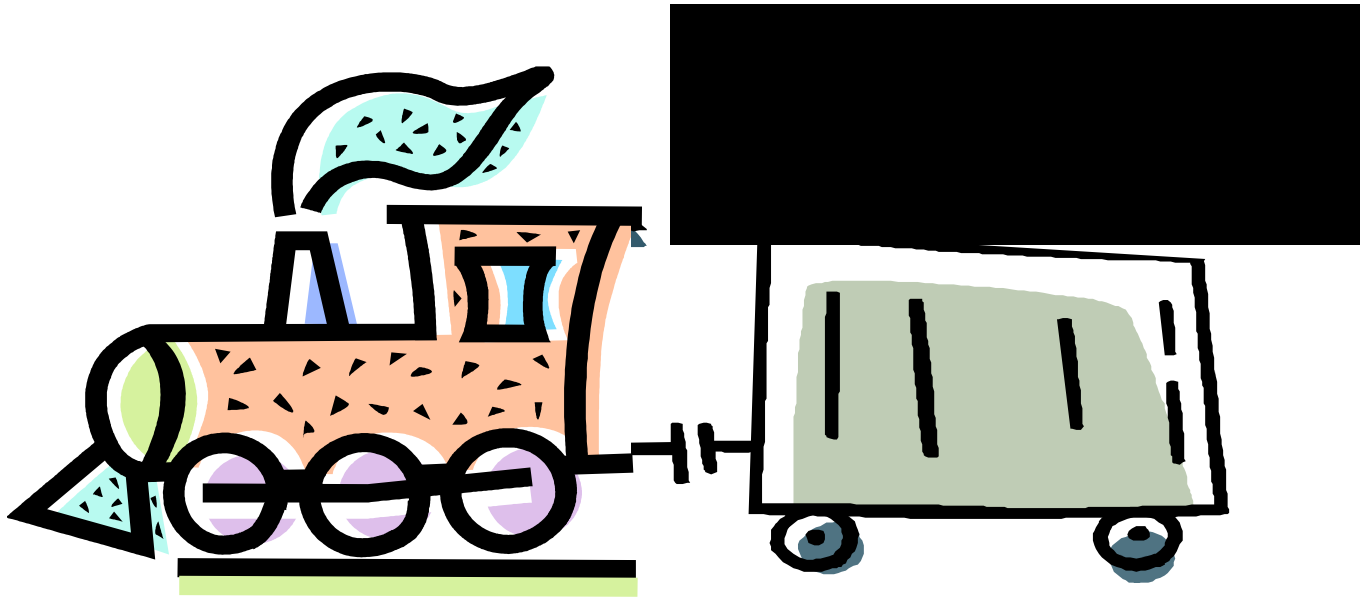
