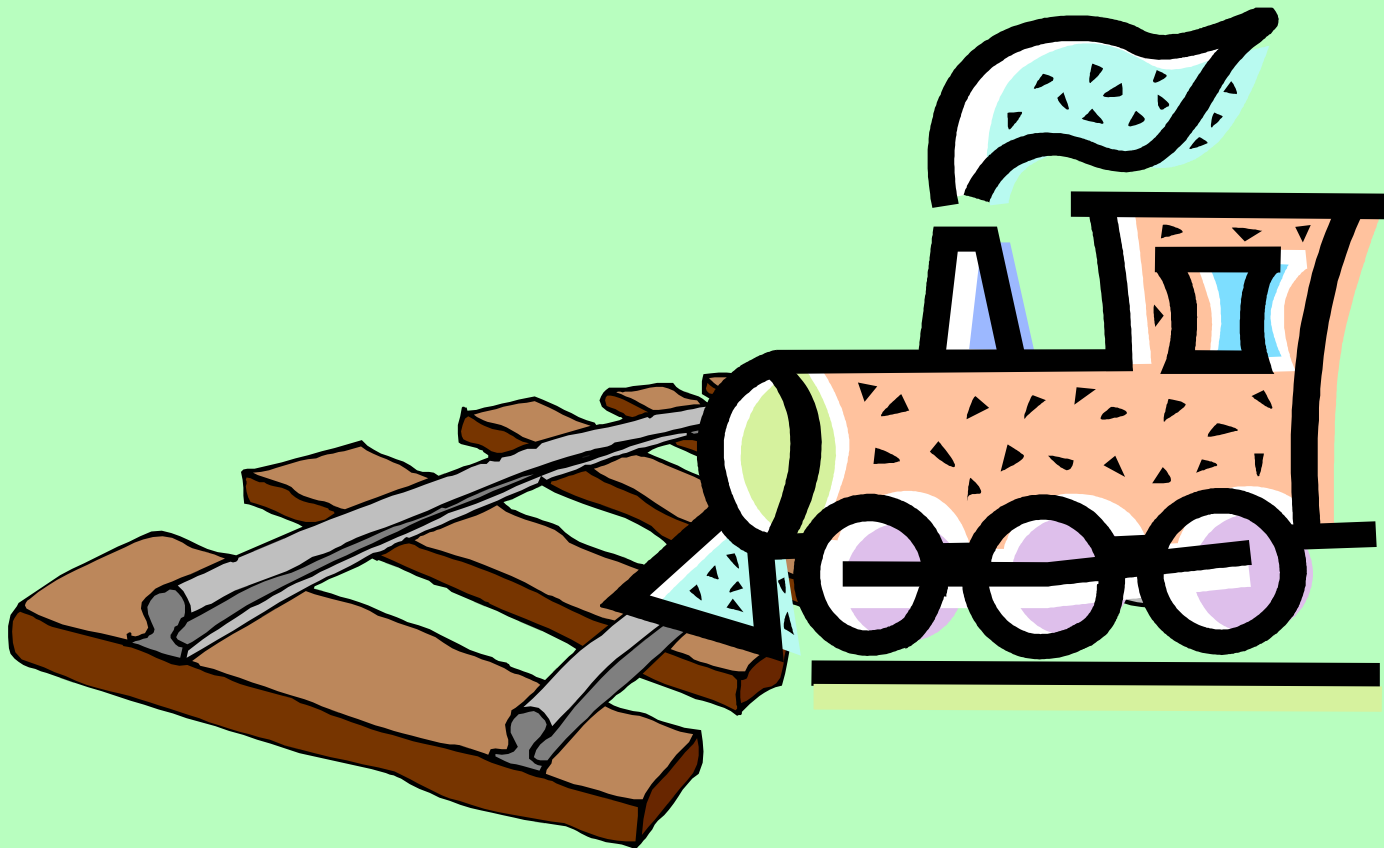
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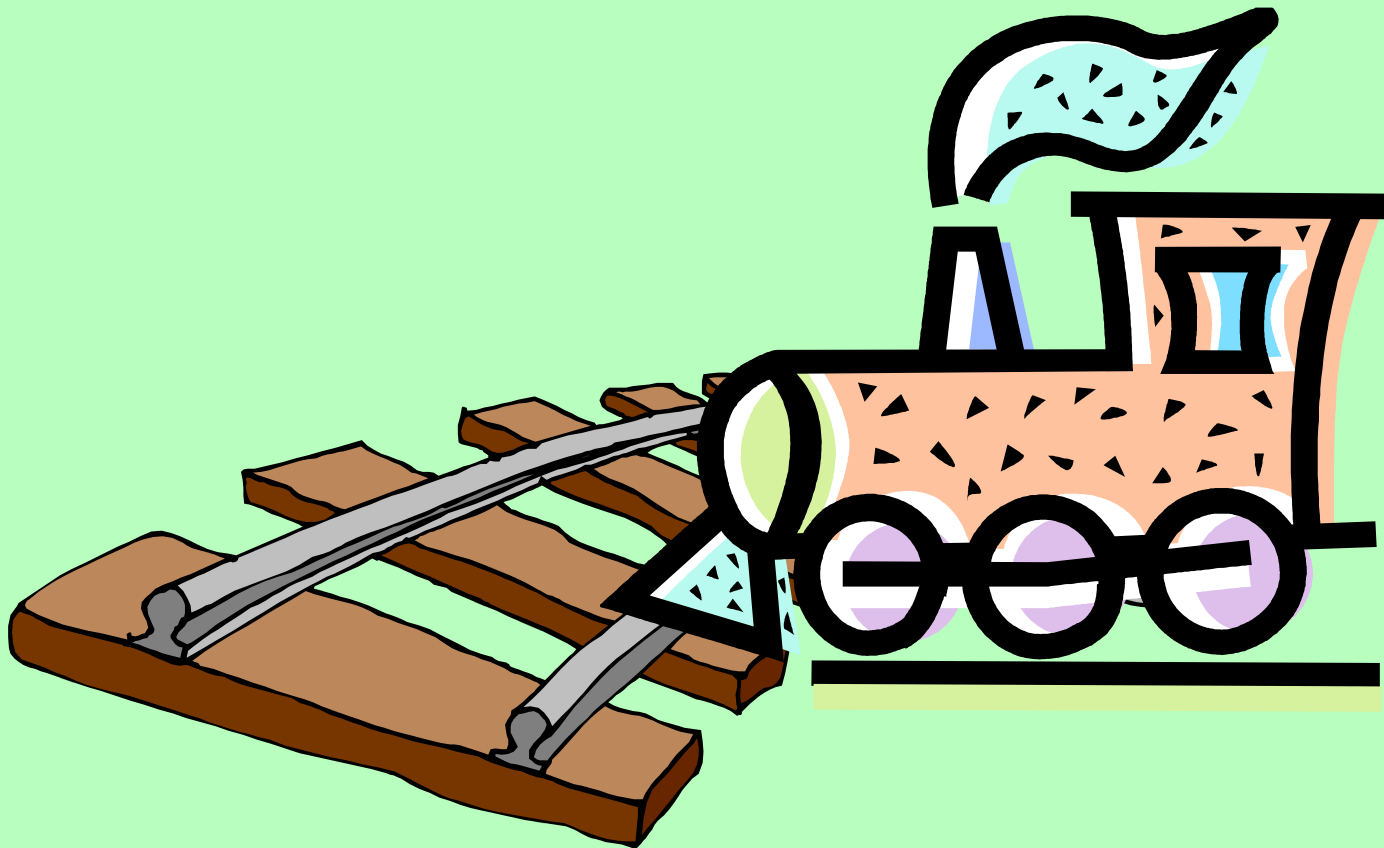


Travis the Train Goes on an

and started to look for eggs.



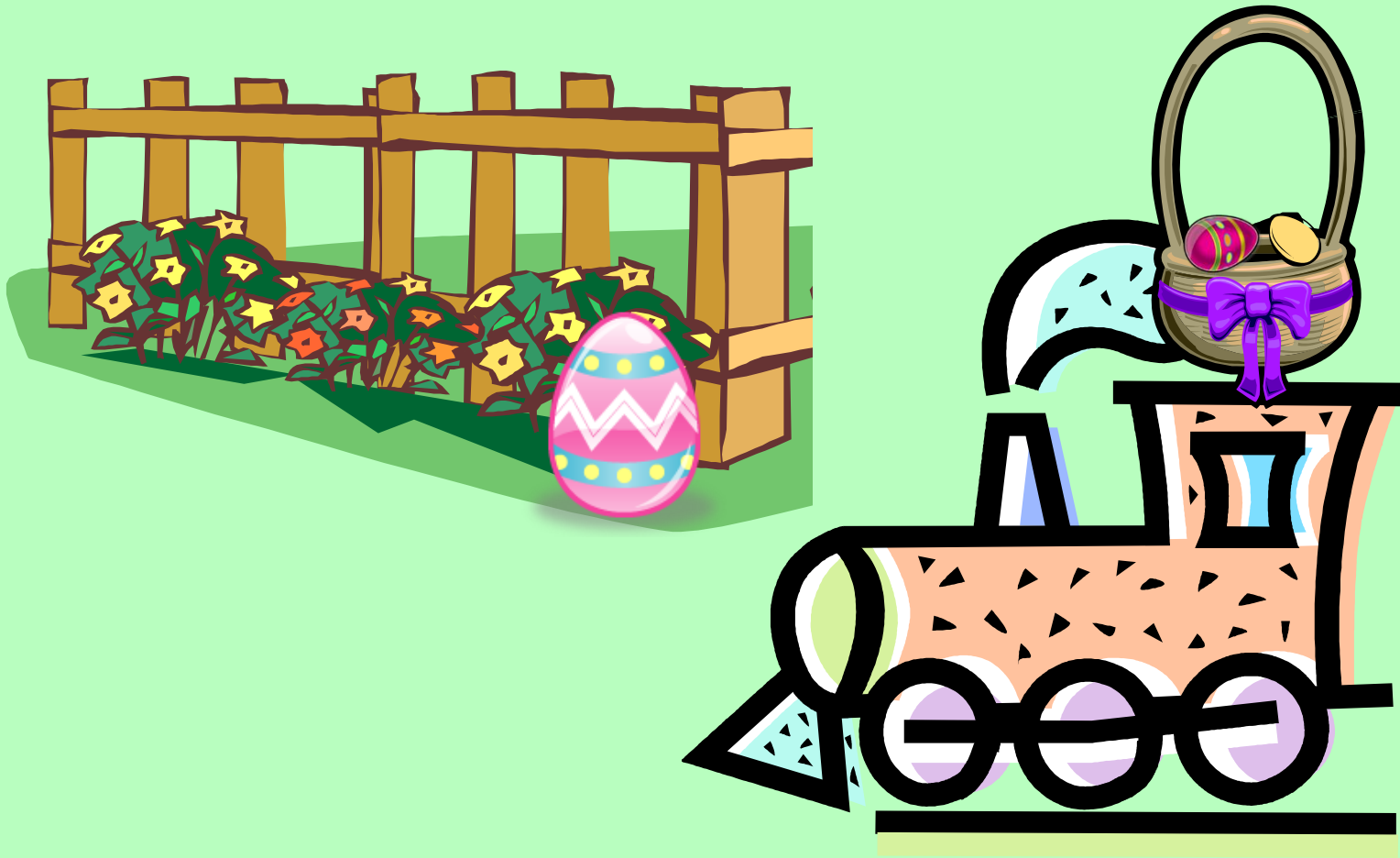
He found one egg by a tree.



He found one egg in the grass.



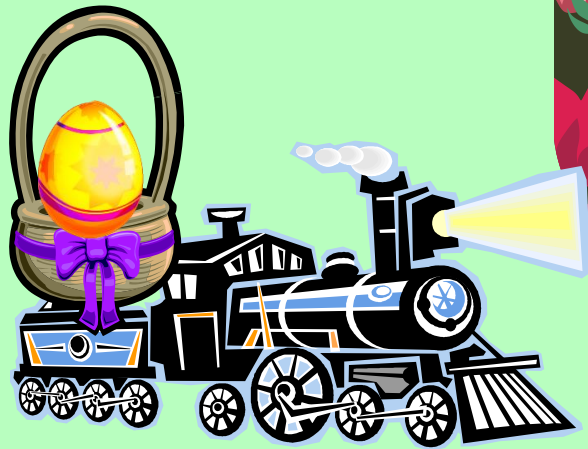
He found one egg by a fence.
