

Playing "Pin the Tail on the Donkey"




Pin the Tail on the donkey is a game kids might play at a party.



There is a big picture of a donkey on the wall.



Each kid gets a pretend donkey tail to put on the donkey picture.



To make it fun, the kids will wear blindfolds when they put on the tail.




On my turn, a friend or adult will put a blindfold over my eyes.




They will spin or turn me around.




I will leave the blindfold over my eyes, and try to put the tail on the donkey.




After I put my tail on the donkey, I can take off my blindfold to see where it is.
